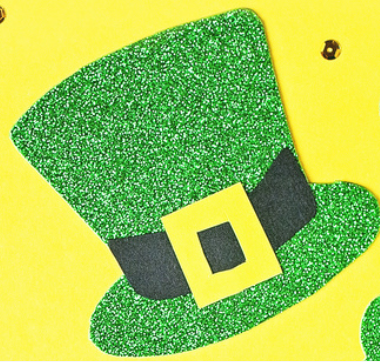

According to legend he **drove** the snakes out of Ireland. He died in 461 and he became the **patron** saint of Ireland. In 1903 St Patrick's Day, also known as **feast** day, became a national holiday, celebrated on the day of the saint's **death**. Irish **immigrants** brought the tradition to the USA in the 1700s. In 1737 the first St Patrick's Day parade was held in **Boston**. The largest parade today is in **New York**. There are 34 million Americans who claim to have Irish **ancestry**, that's why this holiday has become one of the largest in the USA.
