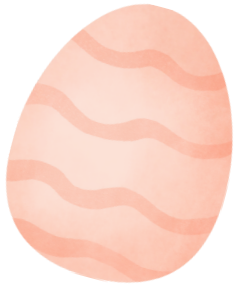
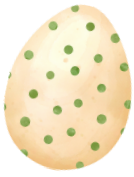

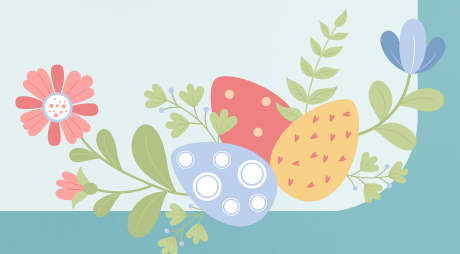
Happy Easter!
